

## Audiology and Ear Care Services

Queens Road Medical Practice's audiology and ear care services are hosted at Le Longfrie Surgery, offering comprehensive assessment and treatment of ear and hearing problems.

Ear Syringing is performed by practice nurses and is suitable for wax removal in uncomplicated cases.

Microsuction is performed by Dr Mitchell and Dr Dorrian and is suitable for removal of wax in all patients of all ages and for treatment of otitis externa (swimmer's ear)

Tympanometry is performed by Dr Mitchell and is used in the assessment of middle ear problems including glue ear and is also used to determine safety to fly and dive.

Hearing Tests are performed by Nurses Mandy Damarell, Diane Barrow and Pat Kennedy

Hearing Aids - 'Hidden Hearing' are our audiologists. They visit once a week and provide a full hearing aid service. If your ears need to be cleaned at the same time, this can be done by Dr Mitchell.

Dizziness and Vertigo – Dr Mitchell has a particular interest in Ear, Nose and Throat (ENT) problems including vertigo and balance disorders.
